The final meeting of the PROTECT project took place at the Convitto of Avellino, with 14 partners participating to review the project's progress and finalize future tasks. The meeting began with a warm welcome from the host school, followed by an in-depth project discussion.

The collaborative efforts and detailed planning discussed during this meeting underscore the project's commitment to enhancing educational practices through innovative, hybrid learning methods.

The importance of virtual mobility was a key topic, with new students testing the online platform and metaverse section. This digital component aims to enhance the educational experience by incorporating immersive technologies like Oculus Quest, allowing students to engage deeply with the edu-larp content.



Edu-Larp Experimentation Highlights

The meeting featured presentations on the progress of edu-larp activities. For instance, Convitto showcased its innovative work on creating a metaverse environment using the Spatial app. This virtual space features interactive rooms and games focused on water protection, developed through collaborative brainstorming sessions with students and tutors.



Key Developments and Responsibilities

Several important materials and tasks were highlighted during the meeting:

- Questionnaires: Developed to assess the impact of edu-larp on students, these questionnaires will be administered both at the beginning and end of the experimentation phase, providing comprehensive data on the edu-larp's effectiveness.
- Video Documentation: Schools were tasked with creating videos documenting their edu-larp activities. Curva Polar will assist in editing and compiling these videos into a final, high-quality product that will be disseminated widely.
- National Reports: Each school prepared a report in their national language and in English, detailing their edu-larp activities and the results achieved. These reports will be integrated into the final Handbook.
- Final Handbook: This evidence-based guide will summarize the project's experiences and outcomes, providing practical guidance for implementing edu-larp. It will be published in English and translated into four additional languages.



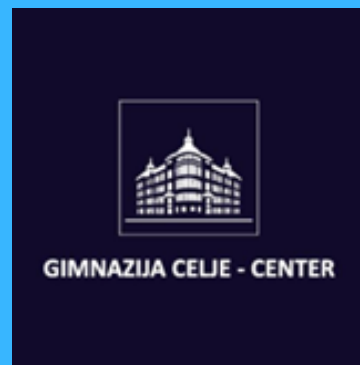
Project Platform
